The Esperance Nyungar Determination provides, by order of the Federal Court, that the Esperance Nyungar People are:

- **1.** Those Aboriginal people who are:
 - a. The descendants of:
 - 1. Sambo = Weegie (aka Durdap) of Esperance
 - 2. Maggie Munroe (nee Bland) of Esperance
 - 3. Charlie Nine of Thomas River
 - 4. Wynbert of Bandy Creek
 - 5. Jack Boxer = Mary of Esperance
 - 6. White Ann (aka Anna Whitehead or Ponton) of Thomas River;
 - 7. Maggie of Thomas River (including the descendants of Yorkshire Bob = Bessie Bevan); and
 - b. Jean McKenzie, who has historical and cultural connections to country included in the Determination Area;

AND

2. Who identify themselves as Esperance Nyungars under the traditional laws and customs of the Esperance Nyungars and are so identified by other Native Title Holders as Esperance Nyungars;

AND

3. Who have a connection with the land and waters in the Determination Area, in accordance with the traditional laws acknowledged and the traditional customs observed by the Esperance Nyungars.

This form is designed to assist us in assessing your application for membership on the basis of the three criteria provided above 1) Ancestry/Family Connection, 2) Identity, and 3) Connection to Country

ETNTAC membership is reserved for those people who satisfy criteria 1, 2 and 3. If you are an Esperance Nyungar person by descent (criteria 1) and your application is unsuccessful because you do not satisfy criteria 2 (identity) or criteria 3 (connection to country), we encourage you to come to Esperance and reconnect with country, community and culture, so that you may re-apply for membership to ETNTAC in the future. Every Esperance Nyungar person (by descent) has the right to establish and maintain a connection to country, and it is never too late.
